Responding to the challenges brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic and the ongoing Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ), Malayan High School of Science has implemented changes in the delivery of its classes and its office processes to adapt to the needs and concerns of its students, employees, and other members of its community.

When is the start of SY 2020-2021?

MHSS will start its SY 2020-2021 in July. However, this may change depending on the decision of the Department of Education or the National Government in relation to COVID-19.

When and how can we enroll for SY 2020-2021?

The enrollment for SY 2020-2021 is ongoing. MHSS is currently conducting online entrance examinations and online enrollment. When will the report cards of MHSS students be released?

We don't have the complete requirements for enrollment yet because of the ECQ. Can we still enroll?

Yes. Just apply online at www.malayanscience.edu.ph/Applicant.aspx. After submitting your application, the Admissions Office will get in touch with you for the entrance examination. The Admissions Office will also announce the extended deadline of enrollment requirements submission once the ECQ is lifted. Regularly visit www.malayanscience.edu.ph for important announcements.

What will be the mode of delivery of classes this coming school year?

Keeping in mind the health and safety of our students while aiming to continue to deliver quality education, MHSS will adopt blended learning (part face-to-face, part online). This is to help mitigate the risk of COVID-19 infection by lessening the need to physically go to school and enforcing social distancing.
